SPRINGWOOD BOWLING & RECREATION CLUB – You'll arrive at the Club at around 9.30am, in time for a delicious Morning Tea, consisting of self-serve Tea and Coffee, a Mini Sweet Muffin, a Baked Sweet Pastry, and a Melting Moment Biscuit.

LEURA FIRST SUNDAY MARKETS – This busy Market has been operating for over 19 years in the grounds of the Leura Public School. The Market contains stalls packed with fresh produce, locally made arts and crafts, plants, books, music, vintage & collectables, homewares, giftware, women's clothing, fashion accessories, jewellery, baked goods, tea, coffee, refreshments, and much, much more! You'll have nearly an hour to stroll around the Market, and make some purchases, should you desire. You'll depart from the Market at around 11.40am, to head to the Blackheath Community Markets.

BLACKHEATH COMMUNITY MARKETS – This small village Market is held in the grounds of the Blackheath Public School. Containing between 30 and 40 stalls, the Market encourages artisans to create products using the practice of sustainability, recycling, and upcycling. The Market usually contains stalls packed with products such as ceramics, pottery, jewellery, clothing, books, jams, sauces, plants, fair trade items, honey, fresh produce, skin products, natural soaps, tea, knitted items, wool, shoes, homewares, and much more! You'll have around 40 minutes at this Market, before reboarding the coach for the short journey to Blackheath Shopping Centre.

BLACKHEATH – You'll arrive in this beautiful Blue Mountains town at around 12.45pm - just in time for lunch! One of the favourite eating places in the town is the New Ivanhoe Hotel, which is situated right at the bus stop where you'll disembark from the coach. In the winter months, the Hotel is known for its log fires and delicious home-style meals, including tasty Sunday roasts! If pub food isn't to your taste, there are a number of other eating establishments in the town to enjoy some refreshments. Following lunch, you'll have time to stroll around the shopping centre, and browse inside some of the lovely shops. Many visitors to the town make a beeline for well-known shops such as the Victory Theatre Antique Centre, The House of Wool, women's fashion store Born in the Blue Mountains, and more! You'll depart from Blackheath at around 2.15pm, to head to the thriving Leura Shopping Centre.

LEURA VILLAGE CENTRE – Leura's pretty, tree-lined main street is a great backdrop for browsing through its wonderful antique shops, art galleries, craft shops, fashion outlets and bookstores. Few visitors depart from the town without paying a visit to Josophan's award-winning chocolate shop. If it interests you, why not take the short stroll to one of the Blue Mountains most popular attractions – Bygone Beautys Treasured Teapot Museum & Tearooms. The tearooms and showrooms offer visitors a truly memorable experience! It is the home of the world's largest private collection of teawares, including more than 5,500 teapots from all over the world! The Museum has an entry fee of around \$5.00 per person. The ultimate experience is to enjoy the famous silver service Traditional High Tea, or the ever-popular Devonshire Tea in the Bygone Beautys Tearooms. Visitors can also purchase estate jewellery (gold, silver and diamonds), antiques, collectables and contemporary quality gifts, including a wide variety of boutique teas - all scattered throughout the Retail Emporium. On most days you may catch the proprietor, Maurice Cooper OAM, (better known as The Teapot Man or Mr Teapot) serving customers at the front desk. Maurice will be easily recognisable wearing a bow tie, and will probably be in the midst of selling a diamond ring to a customer. Maurice and some of the staff are themselves great examples of Bygone Beautys! You'll depart Leura at around 4.00pm, to return home.
