THE POINT CAFÉ – Situated in picturesque surroundings, this delightful Café is part of the Gosford Regional Gallery and Edogawa Japanese Gardens complex. After arriving at around 9.30am, you'll sit down to a delicious Morning Tea, consisting of two freshly-baked Plain Scones, with self-serve Strawberry Jam and whipped Cream, along with self-serve Tea and Coffee.

GOSFORD REGIONAL GALLERY & EDOGAWA JAPANESE GARDENS – After enjoying your Morning Tea, you'll have over an hour to wander through the Gallery, and stroll through the stunning Japanese Gardens. The Gallery offers visitors the opportunity to view a wide range of exhibits, such as paintings, photography, sculptures, textile artistry, ceramics and works on paper. During your visit there will be many extra exhibits on display, as all the entries (including the winning entries) in the annual Gosford Art Prize Competition will be on display to the general public. After browsing the Gallery you'll have time to make your way into the Gardens. The Gardens feature a traditional tea house, a dry stone garden, a lake filled with colourful water lilies, running streams, straddled by timber footbridges, a wisteria pergola, and plantings of pines, maples, cherries, azaleas and much more!

THE FRENCH COUNTRY MARKET – You'll arrive at this very popular bi-annual Market at around 11.30am. This unique Market attracts visitors from all over Australia. Whilst listening to a Frenchman playing 'Je regrette rien' on his accordion, you'll be able to browse through a diverse and quality range of stalls packed with everything French – jewellery, home-wares, European style fashion, furnishings, collectables, Lavender products, antique suitcases, vintage items, oils, beauty products, local produce, fresh locally made breads, chocolates, gourmet French pate, cheeses, spiced mushrooms, boutique wines, pastries, and much, much more!

TERRIGAL TOWN CENTRE – After departing from the Market at around 12.45pm, you'll make the short journey to this picturesque seaside resort. Arriving here at around 1.00pm, you'll have nearly two hours to do as you please in the town. With a well-deserved reputation for its great surf beaches, Terrigal is also well-known for its stately row of Norfolk Island Pines that define the beachfront esplanade, and its busy shopping centre containing shops packed with fashion, jewellery, gifts, home décor, home furnishings, shoes, handbags and other accessories, clothing for babies and toddlers, and much more! During your visit, if it's a nice day, why not go for a quick swim, or take a stroll along the beach? Why not purchase fish & chips and sit on the beach, or under the shade of the trees, whilst enjoying the sights and sounds of the seaside? Or you may wish to enjoy lunch in one of the town's many cafes or coffee shops, or go upmarket, and enjoy lunch at the nearby Crowne Plaza Hotel.

KEN DUNCAN GALLERY – You'll arrive at this exciting Gallery at around 3.00pm. Ken Duncan OAM is regarded as one of Australia's most acclaimed landscape photographers, and has gained prominence for his pioneering work with panoramic landscapes and limited edition photographic prints. Although some of Ken's most outstanding photos have been captured, here, in Australia, his photography journey has seen him travel the world, capturing remarkable photos from places such as Africa, the Middle East, North & South America, New Zealand, India, the UK, Europe, and Asia. Ken has produced a number of books featuring his photography, and also produces items such as calendars, postcards, DVDs, jigsaw puzzles, posters, photo blocks, and much more! During your visit to the complex, you'll view a 20-minute informative audio visual presentation in the theatre, have time to wander through the Gallery, visit the exciting Gift Shop, and enjoy some refreshments in the attached Sanctuary Café. Before departing from the complex at around 4.15pm, you'll be given a postcard featuring one of Ken's photos, and the tour guides will be given one of Ken's books to give away to a passenger on each coach by way of a raffle.
