RICHMOND GOOD FOOD MARKETS – This small but quality Market, held in Richmond Park, contains stalls packed with wonderful local produce. The Market is a place for local farmers and quality food producers to showcase their wares, and interact with the community. Purchasing products at this Market will give you the opportunity to support local farmers; avoid chemicals and other additives that are routinely used in mass produced farms, and source great tasting food. After visiting the market, you'll have sufficient time to wander through the Park and, if you wish, to visit the nearby shops, or pop into one of the town's cafes or coffee shops to enjoy a drink and something tempting to eat! You'll depart Richmond at around 11.15am to head to Mt Tomah.

MT TOMAH BOTANIC GARDEN – You'll arrive at the Garden at around 12.00pm. The Mount Tomah Botanic Garden lies on a basalt-capped peak in the rugged Blue Mountains. Situated 1000 metres above sea level, and having rich volcanic soil, and a cool climate, makes the site ideal for growing one of the world's finest collections of cool-climate plants. During your visit, you will see a wide range and presentation of plants from all over the world, many of which will be in full Spring bloom! You'll experience the picturesque and expansive views across the valleys and ranges of the northern Blue Mountains while meandering through this delightful garden. Relax and soak up the beauty that abounds in the many themed areas and dedicated walks. What better time of the year could you wish to visit the garden, than Spring! During your visit, you'll have time to enjoy lunch in either the Garden's Ugly Mug Kiosk or The Potager Restaurant. The Ugly Mug Kiosk offers food choices such as Quiche, Pies, Sausage Rolls, Sandwiches, Tea, Coffee and cold Drinks. The Restaurant offers more substantial meals, offering choices such as Burgers, Steak, Barramundi, Pot Pie and Vegetarian options. The Potager Restaurant also offers a tempting range of Desserts. If you would like to book a table in the Restaurant, to ensure that you don't miss out on the day, please call 4567 2575 at least one week prior to the tour. You'll depart from the Garden at around 2.15pm.

THE BILPIN FRUIT BOWL – You'll arrive at the very popular tourist attraction at around 2.30pm. This large shop is part of the adjacent Todrosse family orchard, and is packed with a wide range of products such as Fruit, Vegetables, Honey, locally-made Jams, Bilpin Apple Juice, the famous Hillbilly Apple Cider, and a tempting range of home-baked products such as Apple Pies, Cakes and Slices.

LINDT CHOCOLATE FACTORY OUTLET – This amazing factory shop sells over 25 flavours of chocolate, including dark, milk, white, cappuccino, strawberries and cream, lemon, salted caramel, and many more! For much of the year, many of the chocolates are sold at a 50% discount, including the 'Pick & Mix' range. Lovers of the 100g Chocolate blocks can snap up three for around \$8.00, and the 300g Lindt Gold bars are sometimes priced at around \$14.00! You're sure to be tempted! You'll depart from the Factory Outlet at around 4.45pm.

STARBUCKS – MARSDEN PARK – After departing from the Lindt Chocolate Factory Outlet, you'll drive to the end of the street, to arrive at this modern, trendy coffee shop. Upon arrival you'll have around 30 minutes to use the restrooms (the Lindt Chocolate Factory Outlet no longer allows visitors to use their restrooms) and, if you wish, to enjoy a hot or cold drink and one of the very tempting available cake or dessert options. You'll depart from Starbucks at around 5.30pm, to return home.
