ITINERARY

Day 1: Monday 29 January 2018 – Central Coast, Crossroads, South Goulburn, Majura Park, Braidwood, Batemans Bay

Inclusions: *Three-Course Alternate Drop Dinner & 4-Star Accommodation*

This morning, between 5.00am and 6.30am, you'll be collected from either outside or close to your home (this service will be available to most people living east of the Pacific Highway between Lake Munmorah and Kariong), and head to **Uncle Leo's Roadhouse**, near Crossroads, where you'll have time to enjoy a coffee, and use the restrooms, before, at around 9.15am, commencing your journey to the Sapphire Coast. After travelling through the picturesque Southern Highlands, you'll arrive at **Trapper's Bakery**, in **South Goulburn**, where you'll have a 30-minute rest stop to enjoy some of the amazing bakery items on offer, before heading to **Majura Park**, on the outskirts of Canberra, where you'll have another 30-minute rest stop. At this point the Canberra-based passengers will join the tour. After departing from Majura Park, you'll head to the town of **Braidwood**, where you'll have over an hour to stroll through the shopping centre, which contains a range of interesting shops packed with art, craft, antiques, fashion and much more! After departing from Braidwood you'll travel on the Kings Highway, down Clyde Mountain, to the picturesque seaside resort of **Batemans Bay**. Upon arrival, you'll check into what is regarded as the best accommodation venue in the Bay – **Lincoln Downs Resort**. You will not have to touch your luggage. A porter has been organised to convey your luggage from the coach to the door of your bedroom. To help facilitate prompt delivery of your luggage to your room, please ensure that your name is clearly displayed on your luggage! This lovely Resort is set amidst ten acres of English style gardens, on the edge of a picturesque private lake, complete with a white gazebo. Not only does the Resort feature an outdoor heated swimming pool, but also a tennis court and a gym! After settling into your room, you'll have time to relax before heading into the Resort's award-winning **Briars Restaurant**, for a delicious **Three-Course Alternate Drop Dinner**. For Entrée, you'll be served either Smoked Salmon & Asparagus Tart, accompanied by a Salad Garnish, or Caramelised Onion, Goat's Cheese & Pumpkin Tart, accompanied by a Salad Garnish. For Main Course, you'll be served either Roast Pork with Crispy Crackling and Apple Sauce, served with Baked Potatoes, Baked Pumpkin, Steamed Garden Vegetables, Honeyed Carrots and Gravy, or Roast Lamb with Mint Jelly, served with Baked Potatoes, Baked Pumpkin, Steamed Garden Vegetables, Honeyed Carrots and Gravy. For Dessert, you'll be served either Individual Chocolate Mousse, served with Freshly Whipped Cream, garnished with Fresh Berries, or Individual Meringue Nest, served with Fresh Berries, a Berry Coulis, and Freshly Whipped Cream. Following dinner, Self-Serve Tea & Coffee will be available.

Day 2: Tuesday 30 January 2018 – Batemans Bay, Mogo, Batemans Bay

Inclusions: *Full Hot & Cold Breakfast, Mogo Zoo Entry, Keeper Talks & Giraffe Feeding, Two-Hour Clyde River Afternoon Tea Cruise, Two-Course Self-Serve Buffet Dinner & 4-Star Accommodation*

Between 7.00am and 8.15am you'll enjoy a **Full Hot & Cold Breakfast** in the Resort's Briars Restaurant, before boarding the coach at around 8.40am to head for **Mogo Zoo**. This privately owned Zoo features an amazing collection of endangered and exotic animal species; all housed among acres of beautifully landscaped gardens. The Zoo proudly boasts the largest collection of primates in Australia. You'll be able to view Zebras, Southern White Rhinos, Giraffes, Snow Leopards, Meerkats, Sumatran Tigers, African Lions, Deer, and much more! Upon arrival, you'll have nearly three hours to browse around the animal exhibits, visit the coffee shop, as well as the amazing Gift Shop. During your visit, you may wish to take in one of the Keeper Talks. The first of these will be held at 10.30am at the Silvery Gibbon enclosure, and at 11.00am, another talk will be conducted during the feeding of the White Lions. Included in your visit to the Zoo will be an opportunity to personally feed a Giraffe. You'll depart from the Zoo at around 12.00pm to head to the quaint shopping village of **Mogo**. This small village is packed with shops filled with art, craft, books, ceramics, home décor, collectables, antiques, fashion, jewellery, candles, timber products, chocolates, fudge, gelato and much more! After having around 90 minutes to stroll around the shopping centre, and to enjoy some refreshments in one of the village's many cafes and coffee shops, you'll head to **Batemans Bay Shopping Centre**. You'll have over an hour to stroll around this bustling, modern shopping centre, before making your way to the nearby Innes Boatshed, on the banks of the Clyde River, where you'll board **The Escapade**, operated by Merinda River Cruises, for a **Two-Hour Clyde River Afternoon Tea Cruise**. During your relaxing cruise, you'll enjoy the picturesque scenery along the river, and be provided with informative commentary by the captain. At the completion of the cruise, you'll reboard the coach to make the short journey back to the Resort. After having time to freshen up, you'll head into the Resort's Briars Restaurant for a **Two-Course Self-Serve Buffet Dinner**. The Main Course Buffet will consist of Roast Fillet of Beef in a Red Wine Jus, Herb-Roasted Chicken Thighs in a Wine Cream Sauce, Salmon Fillets in a Lemon Butter Sauce, Baked Potatoes, Baked Pumpkin, Baked Sweet Potato, Steamed Garden Vegetables tossed in Butter and Herbs, and a Tossed Garden Salad. The Dessert Buffet will consist of Sticky Date Pudding with a Butterscotch Sauce, Plain Cheesecake with a Berry Topping and Tiramisu. Following dinner, Self-Serve Tea & Coffee will be available.

Day 3: Wednesday 31 January 2018 – Batemans Bay, Central Tilba, Bermagui, Cobargo, Eden

Inclusions: *Full Hot & Cold Breakfast, Three-Course Dinner & 4-Star Accommodation*

This morning your **Full Hot & Cold Breakfast** will be served in the Resort's Briars Restaurant between 6.30am and 7.45am. A porter has been organised to collect your luggage from outside your room and convey it to the coach. The afternoon before, you'll be notified what time you'll need to have your luggage outside your room ready for collection. You'll depart from the Resort at around 8.30am, to head to the picturesque village of **Central Tilba**. Set against the magnificent backdrop of Mt Dromedary, this quaint village is a perfectly restored and maintained period village, protected by National Heritage listing. In recent times, the village has become more widely known due to the television series 'River Cottage Australia', which was filmed in and around the village. The village features a host of unique shops and galleries, showcasing antiques, collectables, craft, art, textiles, estate and contemporary jewellery, fashion, leatherwork, candles, books, woodwork, homewares, gifts, and much, much more! Upon arrival in the village, the coach will park outside the **Central Tilba ABC Cheese Factory**, where a staff member will board the coach to welcome you to the Village, and provide you with details about the Cheese Factory. Although members of the general public are not permitted to visit the Factory, they are most welcome to visit the Factory's wonderful shop! Established in 1891, the Factory is still known for its famous Tilba Club Cheese. During your visit to the shop, you'll be able to enjoy a free Cheese Tasting, as well as taste the largest range of Honey produced on the South Coast. The shop also features a range of local produce, including jams and preserves, as well as souvenirs, gifts, coffee and ice-cream. After visiting the Cheese Factory shop, you'll have around 90 minutes to stroll through the delightful shopping centre, and to enjoy some refreshments in one of the village's many eating establishments. Be sure to call in to see Ken & Linda in the Post Office! Upon opening the door, you'll see it is far, far more than a Post Office! A visit to this shop is a must for any visitor to the village! After departing from the village at around 11.30am, you'll head straight to **Bermagui**. This picturesque seaside resort is famous for its deep sea and game fishing, including yellow fin tuna and marlin, as well as estuary fishing in the surrounding rivers and lakes. The little shopping centre has a lovely range of shops packed with fashion, jewellery, gifts, homewares, home décor and much more! During your visit you'll have sufficient time to enjoy lunch in one of the town's many cafes or coffee shops. If it's a nice day, you may wish to purchase fish and chips and sit on the banks of the river to enjoy the atmosphere. After departing from Bermagui, at around 1.30pm, you'll head to the wonderful shopping village of **Cobargo**. This village combines the skills and craft of a working village with a real historic past. Many of the shops are housed in the village's turn-of-the-century buildings, which significantly adds to the atmosphere and ambiance. Again, the shops in this village are an absolute feast for shoppers, with shops filled

with unique products such as art, craft, fashion, jewellery, pottery, leather goods, and much more! It is not rare to see artisans working on their products during your visit to these shops. You'll depart from the village at around 3.30pm, to head straight to **The Coachman's Rest Motor Inn**, on the outskirts of the far South Coast town of **Eden**. This will be your base for the next four nights. After being purchased recently by new owners, this Motor Inn has been completely renovated and refurbished, and all the bathrooms feature a walk-in shower. Set on two acres, the Motor Inn features a swimming pool, free WIFI, and the highly regarded Coachman's Restaurant. Upon arrival, again, a porter has been organised to convey your luggage from the coach to the door of your bedroom. After settling in, and having time to freshen up, you'll make your way to the Motor Inn's **Coachman's Restaurant**, where you'll sit down to a delicious **Three-Course Dinner**. For Entrée, you'll be offered a choice of either Creamy Pumpkin Soup, served with grilled Ciabatta Bread, or Grilled Chicken Skewers, topped with a Mild Satay Sauce, served on a bed of steaming White Rice. For Main Course, you'll be offered a choice of either Oven-Baked Barramundi Fillet, served with Lemon & Thyme Butter, Potato Chips and Fresh Garden Salad, or Saltbush Lamb Rack, cooked medium, served with Herb-Crushed Potato, Seasonal Greens, and a Marsala & Rosemary Jus. For Dessert, you'll be offered a choice of either Triple Chocolate Brownie, served with Salted Caramel, Pistacio Nut Praline, and Vanilla Bean Ice-Cream, or Warm Banana Pudding, topped with Hot Walnut and Butterscotch Sauce, served with Vanilla Bean Ice-Cream. Following dinner, Self-Serve Tea & Coffee will be available.

Day 4: Thursday 1 February 2018 – Eden

Inclusions: *Full Hot & Cold Breakfast, Two-Hour Twofold Bay Morning Tea Cruise, Entry & Guided Tour of the Eden Killer Whale Museum, 75-Minute Informative Guided Coach Tour of Eden, Three-Course Dinner & 4-Star Accommodation*

This morning, between 7.00am and 8.30am, you'll enjoy a **Hot & Cold Breakfast** in the Motor Inn's Coachman's Restaurant. You'll depart from the Motor Inn at around 9.00am, to head straight to **Eden Wharf**, where you'll board a specially built 16 metre catamaran operated by Cat Balou Cruises, for a **Two-Hour Twofold Bay Morning Tea Cruise**. The picturesque Twofold Bay is surrounded by the Ben Boyd National Park and State Forest, and features stunning scenery, pristine bays, and remote beaches. The cruise will highlight the history of this former whaling port, and will include information about points of interest such as Boyd's Tower, Seahorse Inn at Boydtown, Edrom Lodge, and the various whaling station sites. The naval wharf, woodchip mill, mussel farms, Quarantine Bay, and the fishing fleet will also be viewed during the cruise. If you're fortunate, you may also see some of the Bay's resident dolphins and seals as well! After enjoying a light **Morning Tea** consisting of Tea, Coffee and Biscuits, the vessel will return to the wharf at around 11.30am, where you'll reboard the coach for the short journey into **Eden Shopping Centre**. After arriving in the shopping centre, you'll have around two hours of free time to browse through some of the main street's interesting shops, and enjoy some refreshments in one of the town's cafes, bakeries or hotels. **Martins Pie Place** is one of the best bakeries in town, and has a wonderful range of pies, sausage rolls, and old-fashioned cakes, slices and tarts! During your visit to the town, be sure to visit '**Art on Imlay**' – a large shop that houses a wonderful range of locally produced art and craft. This shop is a must visit for all visitors to the town! You'll depart from the shopping centre at around 1.45pm, for the very short drive to the **Eden Killer Whale Museum**. This popular Museum has been in operation for over 85 years, and is a publicly owned facility. The building is situated overlooking the Pacific Ocean where, in the season, whales may be seen from the various vantage points. The Museum features exhibits about the shore-based whaling operations in Twofold Bay during the 1800s and early 1900s, and includes a full skeleton of 'Tom'; the legendary Orca Killer Whale. This Whale led a pack of Killer Whales in the hunt for Baleen Whales on their southward migration each year. There is also an exhibition relating to the involvement of local indigenous Australians in shore-based whaling. The Museum also houses a full scale model of the type of whale boat used in whale chases out of Twofold Bay. Exhibitions depicting the local fishing and timber industry tell of the extremely important role that these industries have had, and continue to have in the Eden community. Upon arrival, you'll be taken on a **45-Minute Guided Tour** of the Museum, before having free time to visit the Museum's exciting Gift Shop. After departing from the Museum at around 3.15pm, you'll head straight to the Eden Visitor Information Centre, where a local Tour Guide will board the coach, and take you on a **75-Minute Informative Guided Tour of Eden**. During the Tour, you'll be given an informative talk about the history of the town, and be shown a number of the town's important buildings, including the famous Mary McKillop Hall. During the Tour, you'll visit the Rotary Park Lookout, where you'll have around 20 minutes to make the short stroll to the Lookout, to enjoy the picturesque view of Twofold Bay. The Guided Tour will conclude at around 4.45pm, and you'll arrive back to the Resort at around 5.00pm. You'll have time to relax and freshen up prior to making your way to the **Coachman's Restaurant**, where you'll sit down to a lovely **Three-Course Dinner**. For Entrée, you'll have the choice of either Thai Fish Cakes, served with a Chili-Mirin Dipping Sauce and a Salad Garnish, or Potato & Leek Soup, served with crusty Ciabatta Bread. For Main Course, you'll have the choice of either Pan-Fried Chicken Breast Supreme, served with Steamed Greens and a Brandy Fig Sauce, or Seasoned Pork Cutlet, served on a Sweet Potato Mash, with Steamed Green Vegetables and a Spicy Apple Chutney. For Dessert, you'll have the choice of either White Chocolate & Raspberry Cheesecake, or Frozen Pistachio Nut & Praline Torte, served with a Brandy Cardamon Glaze. Following dinner, Self-Serve Tea & Coffee will be available.

Day 5: Friday 2 February 2018 – Eden, Tathra, Bega, Candelo, Eden

Inclusions: *Full Hot & Cold Breakfast, Morning Tea at the Tathra Hotel, Entry & Meet the Keeper Talk at 'On the Perch', 40-Minute Guided Tour & Oyster Tasting at Wheeler's Oyster Farm, Three-Course Dinner & 4-Star Accommodation*

This morning, between 7.00am and 8.00am, you'll enjoy a **Hot & Cold Breakfast** in the Motor Inn's Coachman's Restaurant. You'll depart from the Motor Inn at around 8.30am to head straight to the **Tathra Hotel**, where you'll enjoy a lovely **Morning Tea** consisting of a Mini White Chocolate & Blueberry Muffin, an Apple & Rhubarb Streusel Slice, an Anzac Biscuit, as well as your choice of Tea or Espresso Coffee. Following Morning Tea, you'll walk to the close-by Tathra Wharf Lookout, which offers sweeping views of the Pacific Ocean coastline, and the nearby Tathra Wharf. You'll reboard the coach at the Lookout and head straight to '**On the Perch**'. This complex houses over 75 species of birds from Australia and around the world in five different exhibits. Upon arrival, you'll be given a '**Meet the Keeper**' **20-Minute Informative Talk** about the birds, and hear about the local efforts that are being made to conserve and rehabilitate threatened and endangered birds. You'll have time to explore the different aviaries, and to visit the complex's Café and Gift Shop. After departing from the complex you'll head to the **Bega Cheese Heritage Centre**. Situated adjacent to the famous Bega Cheese Factory, the Centre, built in 1993, is a faithful reconstruction of the original 'Creamery' building that was constructed as part of the Factory in 1899. Unfortunately, public tours are no longer permitted in the Factory, so the Centre is used to tell the story about Bega Cheese, and the history of the Factory. The Centre houses a small Museum, which tells the history of dairying in the Bega Valley, and contains equipment that was used in local dairy farms during the early 1900s. The Centre also features 'The Spotted Cow Gallery', which houses the work of local artisans, such as paintings, woodwork, leadlighting and other decorative arts. The Centre's Shop houses a large range of souvenirs, farm-themed giftware, as well as local jams, preserves, honey, and much more! Of course, one of the most important products on sale is Bega's famous Cheese! You'll be able to sample a range of the cheese, including varieties that are only made for export, and are not sold in shops in Australia. The Centre also houses a lovely Café, where you'll be able to enjoy lunch, before departing from the complex at around 2.00pm. After departing from the Centre you'll head straight to the tiny village of **Candelo**. This village, south-west of Bega has been made a designated urban conservation area. It is a largely untouched and attractive village, with timber buildings, featuring shady verandahs, whose appearance creates a feeling of timelessness. You'll have time to take a leisurely stroll through the centre of the village, in which you're sure to enjoy the turn-of-the-century charm. You'll depart from the village at around 3.15pm and head to **Wheeler's Oyster Farm**, which is situated on the outskirts of Pambula. Since the settlement of this region, oyster farming has played an important role in the area's economy. Merimbula Oysters have become famous, both in Australia and overseas, for their excellent quality and flavor. Upon arrival, you'll be taken on an Informative **40-Minute Guided Tour of the Farm**. The Tour will include a visit to the state-of-the-art factory, and you'll hear the complete Oyster story, learn about how they are farmed, and what is involved in the growing process. Following the Guided Tour, if you wish, you can enjoy a free Natural Oyster Tasting. Before departing from the complex, you'll have time to browse around the lovely Gift Shop, and, if you wish, to enjoy

some refreshments in the adjacent Café. You'll arrive back at the Motor Inn at around 5.30pm, and after having around an hour to relax and freshen up, you'll make your way into the **Coachman's Restaurant**, where you'll sit down to a delicious **Three-Course Dinner**. For Entrée, you'll have the choice of either Beef, Barley & Vegetable Soup, served with crusty Ciabatta Bread, or Golden Fried Calamari Rings, served with a Lemon Wedge and Tartare Sauce. For Main Course you'll have the choice of either Slow-Cooked Lamb Shank, served with Potato Mash, Steamed Seasonal Vegetables, and a Rosemary & Red Wine Jus, or Baby Spinach & Pumpkin Risotto, served with Grilled Chicken Breast and Shaved Aged Parmesan. For Dessert, you'll have the choice of either Pavlova, served with Mixed Berries and Whipped Cream, or Chocolate Honeycomb Mousse, served with Whipped Cream. Following dinner, Self-Serve Tea & Coffee will be available.

Day 6: Saturday 3 February 2018 – Eden, Merimbula, Eden

Inclusions: Full Hot & Cold Breakfast, Morning Tea, 45-Minute Guided Tour of Merimbula Aquarium, Three-Course Dinner & 4-Star Accommodation

This morning, between 7.00am and 8.30am, you'll enjoy a **Hot & Cold Breakfast** in the Motor Inn's Coachman's Restaurant. You'll depart from the Motor Inn at around 9.00am and head to **Merimbula Aquarium**. This complex houses a 70,000 litre Oceanarium, and 28 tanks featuring both local and tropical marine life, including sharks, shrimps, octopus, tropical fish, and much more! Upon arrival, you'll sit down to a delicious **Morning Tea** consisting of freshly-baked Scones, with self-serve Strawberry Jam and freshly-whipped Cream. Tea and Espresso Coffee will be served to the table. After enjoying your Morning Tea, you'll be escorted into the Aquarium, where you'll be taken on a **45-Minute Guided Tour**. You'll then have time to browse through the wonderful gift shop, before reboarding the coach at around 11.00am to head to **Merimbula Shopping Centre**. This delightful seaside shopping centre is packed with a range of interesting and unique shops - from clothing to footwear, fishing to sports gear, lollies, gifts, home-wares, books, jewellery and much, much more! You can spend your time browsing through the lovely shops, sit in a café or coffee shop at the water's edge and watch the world go by, stroll along the shoreline, enjoy some lunch in one of the town's cafes, coffee shops, hotels or restaurants – the time is yours to do as you please! You'll depart from Merimbula Shopping Centre at around 1.30pm to head to **Oaklands Barn**, on the outskirts of Pambula. This small complex is home to a number of different businesses, including a gift shop, garden centre, pantry, art gallery, café, a brewery, and more!. You'll have over an hour to stroll around the interesting complex, before reboarding the coach at around 3.00pm, to return to the Motor Inn. After returning to the Motor Inn at around 3.15pm, you'll have free time to do as you please. Perhaps you may wish to visit the Eden Gardens Country Club, which is only a 280-metre walk along a concrete pathway from the Motor Inn, or you may wish to enjoy a swim in the Motor Inn's pool, or you may choose to take a nap, or just relax in your room. At 6.30pm, you are to be seated in the **Coachman's Restaurant**, where you'll sit down to a delicious **Three-Course Dinner**. For Entrée, you'll have the choice of either Thai Beef Salad, served with Warm Crispy Noodles, or Creamy Garlic Galliano Prawns, served atop a bed of Steaming White Rice. For Main Course, you'll have the choice of either Crispy Flathead Fillets, served with Coleslaw, Chips and Tartare Sauce, or Grilled Prime Cut Sirloin Steak, cooked Medium, topped with a Rich Mushroom Ragout, served with Sweet Potato Crisps, and Seasonal Vegetables. For Dessert, you'll have the choice of either Profiteroles, filled with Crème Pâtissière, dipped in Chocolate and Toffee, garnished with Mint and Strawberry, or Apple & Rhubarb Crumble, served with Vanilla Bean Ice-Cream. Again, a Porter will collect your luggage from outside your room and convey it to the coach. After departing from Eden, you'll head up Brown Mountain to the little village of **Nimmitabel**. You'll have around 45 minutes to enjoy some refreshments in either the famous Nimmitabel Bakery or the nearby Berties Café, and take a quick stroll around the village, before departing at around 11.15am to head for **Cooma**. Upon arrival in this bustling town, you'll have around an hour to stroll through the shopping centre, and to enjoy some refreshments in one of the town's cafes, coffee shops or bakeries. After departing from Cooma, you'll head straight to **Calwell Shopping Centre**, on the outskirts of Canberra, where you'll say 'goodbye' to the Canberra-based passengers, and you'll have a quick 30-minute rest stop. After departing from Calwell, you'll head to the BP Service Centre in **Marulan**, where you'll have another 30 minute rest stop. After departing from Marulan, you'll head straight to Uncle Leo's Roadhouse, on the outskirts of Sydney, where you'll have yet another 30-minute rest stop, before departing at around 6.25pm, to be conveyed back to the point where you joined the tour last Monday.
